

How to make a Blossom Burst

Equipment:



Wires



Sugar florist paste



Rolling pin



CelStick



Blossom cutters



Florist Tape



1. Roll out the sugar florist paste on a lightly dusted or greased surface.
2. Cut our blossom shapes using the cutters.
3. Use the Celstick to remove blossom from the cutter.
4. Cut the wires to length required. Gently push a wire in through the side of the blossom, making sure it does not show either side.
5. Leave to dry on a non-stick surface e.g. parchment.
6. Roll a small ball of sugarpaste for the centre of each flower. Press the ball into the centre using a dab of water to stick it in place.
7. Tape the wires together in a bunch. Push a cake pic into the cake and insert the burst.
